School Counselors do the following:

- ◆ **Listening to students' concerns about friends, school, families and helping to resolve conflicts.**
- ◆ **Teaching students about the consequences of their behavior; This includes helping them explore alternative behaviors.**
- ◆ **Making Connections between school and the future. This includes talking about career possibilities and the relationship between school and work/ life skills.**
- ◆ **Consulting with teachers, parents, administrators, and other professionals about resources, programs, and individual and family problems.**
- ◆ **Helping parents understand how to help their children achieve their fullest academic, social, and emotional potential.**
